28% Energy Reduction: How It Was Done, How We Maintain --

In August of 2007, Bridgewater State College (BSC), the Massachusetts Division of Capital Asset Management (DCAM), and Ameresco, Inc. completed a \$10.4 million comprehensive Energy and Water Conservation Project which was part of the College's greening program. Covering 1.5 million square feet across thirty campus buildings, the project provided the college with two distinct benefits. The first is nearly \$1 million in annual energy cost savings, guaranteed and verified by Ameresco over a twenty year performance period. The second is a package of capital improvements to the campus energy systems which will also provide savings through deferred maintenance. The implemented energy conservation measures (ECMs) will also serve as a valuable energy management and monitoring tool for the college's facilities as they continue a progressive policy of environmental responsibility. Bridgewater's initiative in partnering with Ameresco and DCAM's support throughout the project led to the successful and exemplary execution of the state's Energy conservation program. The project was executed and built in 14 months starting March 2006 a true tribute to the College's dedication to improving their campuses and the environment overall.
